National e-Exam System Trials: Phase 3 Robust LMS e-Exams

Fully controlled operating system, office suite, secure browser and a range of 'e-tools of the trade' for BYO Laptops in exams.

- Phase 1 Paper-equivalent: pen or keyboard.
- Phase 2 Post-paper: everyone types. Multimedia and specialist applications.
- Phase 3 Robust LMS (Moodle) with Safe Exam Browser: Resistant to network outages.

Offline or online exam modes







Typical e-Exam trial timeline

One to two weeks prior to exam:

Practice session for typists + Prep USBs.

On the day of the exam: Prep room.

Those typing bring their laptop, a wired mouse and go to the assigned room.

At the end of the exam: complete post-exam surveys.




Funded: Innovation and Development Grant: 2016-2018

1) Boot your laptop with the e-Exam USB stick. Enter your details to connect to the network.



2) Multiple question types, software tools for maths, languages, graphics and multimedia players.





Funded: Multi-language development

3) Auto save to server every 1 minute. Encrypted auto backup to local storage in cases of network outage.



4) Exam continuation and finalisation possible without a network. Multiple language input methods available.
